**CHANGE OF PROGRAM**

Students are responsible for the program selected when registering. Changes may be made online through 09/02/2011 and thereafter by filing a Request to Add or Drop Courses form in the Office of the Registrar. For regularly scheduled courses dropping a course during the first four weeks may be done without being reflected on the transcript. Adds **MUST BE APPROVED BY THE INSTRUCTOR AFTER THE FIRST WEEK OF CLASSES**. For regularly scheduled classes a class may be dropped with a grade of "W" within the fourth through eighth weeks of the semester; thereafter the grade will be recorded as a 'WF' when a student withdraws from a course. There is **NO AUTOMATIC DROPPING** of courses resulting from a student's failure to attend class sessions.

For those courses that are offered on an unusual calendar the following principle applies: withdrawals received in the Office of the Registrar during regular business hours prior to the end of the first quarter of the total number of class hour sessions offered in the course will have no entry made on the transcript; withdrawals received in the Office of the Registrar during regular business hours prior to the end of the second quarter of total number of class hour sessions will receive a 'W' on the transcript; withdrawals received in the Office of the Registrar during regular business hours prior to the last class hour session will receive a grade of 'WF' unless the professor, aware of extenuating circumstances beyond the control of the student, is willing to grant a 'WP.'

**CURRENT STUDENT REGISTRATION PROCEDURE**

Continuing students enrolled in the Spring Semester may initiate registration with their academic advisor. Students may only register online at <http://myvu.vanguard.edu> following a meeting with their academic advisor. Detailed information regarding online registration can be found at <http://registrar.vanguard.edu/registration-information>. Students wishing to register in person may do so on Friday, April 15th, and will need to contact the Office of the Registrar for appropriate registration materials.

**FINANCIAL REGISTRATION**

Payment arrangements for Fall 2011 may be made during the regular hours of the Business Services Office before August 1st. Exact terms and conditions can be obtained from the Business Services Office beginning in June. Those not financially registered by August 1st may be dropped from classes. If dropped from classes due to failure to complete financial registration or registering for classes after August 1st, a late registration fee of \$100 will be charged. The University reserves the right to change tuition, fees, and/or charges without advance notice, should conditions so warrant.

**SEMESTER BILLING**

A Registration Statement, which contains billing information for the registered semester, is mailed to the student's permanent address on record in June. The Registration Statement includes charges for the semester based on academic and student life registration. Financial aid information is included when the student's file has been completed sufficiently for the Financial Aid Office to estimate aid. However, actual awards cannot be made to the student's account until their financial aid file is complete. Financial arrangements must be made with the Business Services Office no later than 08/01/2011 (see general fees listed above). Students receiving financial aid for the full amount of their semester costs must make arrangements with the Business Services Office to complete financial registration by 08/01/2011 as well. *ATTN: Athletes, Student Leaders, Music Students: Financial Registration MUST be completed PRIOR to moving on campus, even if you are required to move in before the Financial Registration deadline. **PAYMENT OPTIONS:**

Vanguard University is pleased to offer our students and families two options to pay tuition. Payments can be made at the Cashier's office if paying in full with cash or check. Payments can also be made online using electronic check and/or credit card through TuitionPay at [www.vanguard.edu/tuitionpay](http://www.vanguard.edu/tuitionpay). TuitionPay, a tuition payment service administered by Sallie Mae, allows students to make a one-time payment or set up a budget to make monthly payments. Students can access their payment accounts 24 hours a day, 7 days a week through InfoLink with TuitionPay.

**OPTION 1 | Pay-In-Full:** Pay the full amount referenced on your Registration Statement by **August 1, 2011**.

**\*\*Please do NOT use this option to make a monthly TuitionPay payment.**

**OPTION 2 | Semester Payment Plan:** Pay your semester balance referenced on your Registration Statement interest free in 5 monthly installments, beginning **July 1st**, or 4 installments, beginning **August 1st**. There is an enrollment fee of \$85 with this plan.

**REFUND POLICY**

The refund schedule of withdrawal from the university or for course load reduction, based on the proper form filed with the Registrar's Office is as follows:

Withdrawal by 09/02/11	100%	Withdrawal by 10/21/11	25%
Withdrawal by 09/23/11	50%	Withdrawal after 10/21/11	0%

Refund schedule applies to tuition, room, board, student services and unused course fees. Students who withdraw or are expelled from the institution may be required to have some or all of their financial aid returned to the various aid programs. Any student who wishes to withdraw from the University must notify the Registrar's Office of their "intent to withdraw". The amount of financial aid to be returned for the student will be calculated based on this date. Federal aid will be returned based on the amount of the semester the student has completed. State and institutional aid will be returned based on the refund percentage applied to the student's institutional charges. See the Financial Aid Office for calculation.
