Admission

The university offers graduate programs in clinical psychology, education, nursing and religion. Prior to registering for classes, all graduate students must be approved for admission as Regular or Provisional standing students.

Advisement

All graduate students must meet with their program for advising on course placement.

Academic Registration Process

Online registration will be available to all current graduate students. Instructions for online registration will be given to students upon meeting with a program advisor. Online registration will be held between April 16-20 for Graduate Psychology students and April 16-September 7 for the other Graduate Programs.

Change of Courses

Changes may be made online through September 7, 2012 and thereafter by filing a Request to Add or Drop Courses form in the Office of the Registrar. All ADD/DROP forms must be signed and approved by the graduate program coordinator. For regularly scheduled courses, dropping a course during the first four weeks may be done without being reflected on the transcript. A regularly scheduled class may be dropped with a grade of "W" within the fourth through eighth weeks of the semester; thereafter, the grade will be recorded as a "WF" when a student withdraws from a course. There is NO AUTOMATIC DROPPING of courses resulting from a student's failure to attend class sessions.

FINANCIAL REGISTRATION

Payment arrangements for the Spring 2012 semester must be made before January 1st, in the Office of Accounting Operations, *formerly Business Services*, during regular business hours. Exact terms and conditions can be obtained from the Office of Accounting Operations, beginning in December. Students who fail to complete Financial Registration by January 1st will be charged a \$100 Late Registration fee. Late Registration fees may also result in being dropped from courses for Spring 2012.

SEMESTER BILLING

A Registration Statement, which contains billing information for the registered semester, is mailed to the student's permanent address on record in December. The Registration Statement includes charges for the semester based on academic registration. Financial aid information is included when the student's file has been completed. **Note: Changes may require an updated Registration Statement upon request.** Financial arrangements must be made with the Office of Accounting Operations, no later than 01/01/2012 (see General Fees listed in the respective Graduate programs). Students receiving financial aid for the full amount of their semester costs must make arrangements with the Office of Accounting Operations, to complete financial registration by 01/01/2012 as well. **To check your Financial Registration status you may email our Student Account Specialists at AccountsReceivable@vanguard.edu.**

PAYMENT OPTIONS:

Vanguard University is pleased to offer our students and families two options to pay semester charges. Payments can be made at the Cashier's Office if paying in full with cash or check. Payments can also be made online using electronic debit and/or credit card through TuitionPay at tuitionpay.salliemae.com/vanguard. TuitionPay, a tuition payment service administered by Sallie Mae, allows students to make a one-time payment or set up a budget to make monthly payments. Students can access their payment accounts 24 hours a day, 7 days a week through InfoLink with TuitionPay.

OPTION 2 | Semester Payment Plan: Pay your semester balance referenced on your Registration Statement interest free in 5 monthly installments, beginning **December 1st**, or 4 installments, beginning **January 1st**. There is an enrollment fee of \$85 with this plan.

REFUND POLICY

The refund schedule for withdrawal from the University or for course load reduction is based on the date the withdrawal form is properly filed with the Registrar's Office. Please see as follows:

Withdrawal by 01/20/2012	100%	Withdrawal by 03/02/2012	25%
Withdrawal by 02/03/2012	50%	Withdrawal after 03/02/2012	0%

Refund schedule applies to tuition, room, board, student services and unused course fees. Students who withdraw or are expelled from the institution may be required to have some or all of their financial aid returned to the various aid programs. Any student who wishes to withdraw from the University must notify the Registrar's Office of their "intent to withdraw". The amount of financial aid to be returned for the student will be calculated based on the withdrawal date. Federal aid will be returned based on the Federal Return of Title IV fund calculations. State and institutional aid will be returned based on the refund percentage applied to the student's institutional charges.
